Thank you for taking the time to contact us. You only need a normal driver's license to operate an RV if it is used for recreational purposes. However, you may need a CDL(commercial driver's license), or another special license, to operate an RV that weighs more than 26,000 lbs., measures more than 45 feet or is towing a second unit like a boat. Each state has its own specific rules regarding this. So it ultimately depends on which states you will be traveling in. You may also need to obtain an international driver's license if your license is not in English format. I hope this helps.
